Stephanie Gooden made a motion to approve a payment schedule. Monte Fenner seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.

County Clerk Brittni Burton presented commission order #6417 in the amount of \$157,907.74 for a cash transfer of payroll, order #6418 in the amount of \$28,513.58 for 941 taxes and order #6412 in the amount of \$3,713.15 for CERF .7% and elective savings. Stephanie Gooden made a motion to approve the commission orders as presented. Monte Fenner seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.

Stephanie Gooden made a motion to approve liquor licenses for Betty's Truck Stop in Sweet Springs/\$103, \$203, Bharti Liquor in Marshall/\$103, \$203, Bud's Café in Marshall/\$50, Holiday Lanes in Marshall/\$13, \$203, \$303, Kazoku Hibachi in Marshall/\$203, \$303, Last Chance Saloon in Sweet Springs/\$303, Liquor Studio in Marshall/\$103, \$203, Catalpa in Arrow Rock/\$200, \$303, Pop Shop on Odell St. in Marshall/\$103, \$203, Pop Shop on Miami St. in Marshall/\$103, \$203, Margarita's Mexican Cuisine in Slater/\$203, \$303, Mel's Diner in Malta Bend/\$53, Quick Run in Marshall/\$103, \$203 and Slater Quick Stop in Slater/\$103, \$203. Monte Fenner seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.

Monte Fenner made a motion to approve the promotion of Teresa Reeves from Elections Clerk to Deputy County Clerk effective July 3, 2023. Her new rate of pay will be \$17.50 per hour. Stephanie Gooden seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.

Treasurer Jared Brewer stated the sales taxes for July will be received on the 7th and he will have a report at the following meeting.


Stephanie Gooden announced that Gov. Mike Parsons has provided emergency water and hay access to farmers due to the drought. Boat ramps at 25 Missouri state parks will be open for farmers to collect water with almost 700 acres available for haying at 17 state parks. Boat ramps at 36 conservation areas are also open for water collection. The Missouri Department of Transportation is offering special overwidth hauling permits at no charge to help farmers and ranchers move hay as well. In addition, due to the drought the Saline County Commission along with the Saline County Emergency Management Department has issued a burn advisory until July 7, 2023 or until significant rainfall. Citizens should be mindful of open flames, 4th of July fireworks safety, and properly dispose of smoking materials.

Monte Fenner stated Saline County submitted two applications to the Regional Bridge Committee for replacement. The committee will score the submitted bridges by July 20, 2023, and will meet at the district office on July 27, 2023 to select the projects to be funded. Last year, Saline County submitted three applications and was approved for two.

Becky Plattner stated the Commission met with the Saline County Extension office in the previous week. It was a great opportunity to hear more about the programs provided by the Extension office as well as to keep the working relationship strong with Emma Sims, Fred Smith, Annie Luft, and Chelsea Corkins.

Monte Fenner made a motion to recess to adjourn at 12:00 PM. Stephanie Gooden seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.
