Monte Fenner made a motion to approve the minutes from the June 7, 2023 session. Stephanie Gooden seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.

Stephanie Gooden made a motion to approve a payment schedule. Monte Fenner seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.

County Clerk Brittni Burton presented commission order #6410 in the amount of \$158,942.28 for a cash transfer of payroll, order #6411 in the amount of \$28,686.60 for 941 taxes and order #6412 in the amount of \$3,744.31 for CERF .7% and elective savings. Stephanie Gooden made a motion to approve the commission orders as presented. Monte Fenner seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.

County Clerk Brittni Burton presented commission order #6413 in the amount of \$17,721.73 for the April 2023 transfer of CERF collections, order #6414 in the amount of \$15,201.01 for the May 2023 transfer of CERF collections, order #6415 in the amount of \$5,000.72 to add to the County's postage machine and order #6415 as a letter of destruction for two HP monitors from Division VI court. Monte Fenner made a motion to approve the commission orders as presented. Stephanie Gooden seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.

Stephanie Gooden made a motion to approve liquor licenses for La Paz Grocery and Restaurant in Marshall/\$203, \$303, Piggly Wiggly in Sweet Springs/\$103, \$203, Applebee's Bar and Grill in Marshall/\$203, \$303, The Badger's Hideaway in Arrow Rock/\$53, \$203, Mexico Lindo in Marshall/\$203, \$303 and Montague's in Marshall/\$303. Monte Fenner seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.

Bids were opened for the Sheriff's annual request for proposal. One bid was received for food services from Springfield Grocers in Springfield, MO. Stephanie Gooden made a motion to take the bid under consideration and to be reviewed with the Sheriff. Monte Fenner seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.

Stephanie Gooden thanked the Fair Board Association for the use of their parking lot for the countywide cleanup on May 20, 2023. The cleanup received 62 vehicles, 3 gaylords of electronics, 194 tires, 160 yards of debris (approximately 10 tons), 3 yards of textiles, as well as an unknown amount of scrap metal. She thanked everyone who was involved in the cleanup and the County is looking forward to next year's event.

Monte Fenner stated the County's Road and Bridge crew is currently hauling gravel and has one grader touching up rough spots. There are two crews spraying chemicals to keep the weeds down on the sides of the roads. Next week the Road and Bridge department will begin to replace culverts in various parts of the County. 6-8 culverts are expected to be replaced from next week through the end of August.

Becky Plattner thanked County Clerk Brittni Burton for compiling the County's annual Financial Statement. Statements can be picked up in the County Clerk's office or in the rotunda of the Courthouse.


Recorder Jessica Baker announced her office recorded 211 documents and 5 marriage licenses for the month of May. They have also back indexed 1,702 documents and put them online.


Collector Cindi Sims announced the annual tax sale will take place on August 28<sup>th</sup> this year. Certified mail went out on June 16<sup>th</sup>. At that time there were 171 properties eligible for this year's tax sale. The last day to pay to avoid advertisement of the property is June 30<sup>th</sup>.

Sheriff Cindi Mullins announced their new website launched last week and they are working on new content for it. The jail is almost at full capacity and the department is working on grants as well.

County Clerk Brittni Burton announced impact notices were sent out by Assessor Jessica Goodman on June 9, 2023. There were 154 real estate and 956 personal property notices sent. Citizens will need to contact the Assessor's office at 886-3111 for an informal hearing if they disagree with their valuation. Informal hearings need to be completed before July 1<sup>st</sup>. If an informal hearing does not satisfactorily resolve the valuation, appointments can then be made with the Board of Equalization by contacting the County Clerk's office at 886-3331. Appointments with the Board of Equalization will be taken until July 7<sup>th</sup> and all paperwork for the Board will need to be submitted to the County Clerk's office by 4:30 PM on July 7<sup>th</sup>.

Monte Fenner made a motion to recess to adjourn at 12:00 PM. Stephanie Gooden seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.
