Stephanie Gooden made a motion to approve the 2023 payroll and payment schedule as presented by Auditor Karlin Breshears. Monte Fenner seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.

County Clerk Debbie Russell presented commission order #6344 on behalf of Karlin Breshears for year-end budget adjustments to various line items. Monte Fenner made a motion to approve the commission order as presented. Stephanie Gooden seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.

County Clerk Debbie Russell presented commission order #6343 as a ballot measure to be put on the April 4, 2023 ballot for the voters to decide if a countywide sales tax of 3% should be imposed on the sale of recreational marijuana. Stephanie Gooden made a motion to approve the commission order as presented. Monte Fenner seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.

Monte Fenner made a motion to approve the design and engineering services of the sewer system at Marshall Junction. Stephanie Gooden seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.


Monte Fenner made a motion to approve the salaries of the commissioned deputies of the Saline County Sheriff's Department effective January 1, 2023. Stephanie Gooden seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.


Monte Fenner made a motion to approve the bid from SumnerOne for the copiers/printers and postage machine. Stephanie Gooden seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.

Assessor Jessica Goodman announced personal property assessments will be mailed out on December 30, 2022. 8,494 individual assessments will be mailed out this year along with 1,134 business assessments. The e-filing option will be available starting January 3, 2023. New for 2023 will be curbside assessing. Individuals can stay in their car and an assessment employee will come out to assess their property with them at their vehicle. The cost of the 2023 personal property data will be going up from \$1500 to \$10,000. Per state statute, data must be purchased from NADA or their successors. NADA has been recently purchased by JD Power who has decided to raise the cost.

Kile Guthrey announced Saline County will be purchasing \$150,000 of soft match money from Pettis County for \$75,000. The soft match transfer will happen in January.

Monte Fenner made a motion to recess to adjourn at 11:30 AM. Stephanie Gooden seconded. Motion carried 3-0-0.
